

iPad Requirements for Lotic AIM Data Collection

The recommended electronic data capture setup for Lotic AIM is an iPad Air (4th Gen) 64 GB Wi-Fi and cellular enabled device with a 3 GB/month data plan. If electronic data capture setups differ from this, iPads must meet the following specifications:

- Lotic AIM data collection requires the use of iPads
- At minimum users must have iPad Air (3rd Gen or later) or iPad Pros (3rd Gen or later)
- iPads **MUST be both Wi-Fi AND cellular (4G) enabled** (network provider doesn't matter). This is required for the iPad GPS to work.
- iPads must have a cellular data plan with a minimum of 3 GB of data per month and an associated simcard. Crews that rely on using their iPads like a computer to do everything all season long, including sending data, calling in to post trip calls to debrief, and or mid/end of season check ins should consider opting for a larger data plans (>3GB/month). Teams calls have been known to consume a significant amount of data. Crews should utilize Wi-Fi to upload and download files to minimize data plan usage.
- Minimum storage space on iPads is 32 GB minimum. Maps, data, apps and other crew resources tend to eat up a significant amount of this space, so we recommend opting for more storage space on the iPad itself.
- Buying refurbished iPads is a common practice to upgrade your device without being too costly. Not all "refurbished" iPads are the same, so do your research before buying. Only purchase refurbished iPads if they have had their batteries replaced.

- Be sure to verify that the required Flash Drive you purchase for data backup is compatible with your model of iPad (i.e., Pros use a USB Type-C plug while Airs and standard iPads use a Lightning plug).
- A waterproof case, heavy duty straps, and battery pack are HIGHLY recommended for all iPads.

Required iPad Applications and Application Setup

- All applications that are needed will be compatible with the above suggested iPads
